**Participation Policy:** Athletes must register to participate in GCA sports at [www.gracecrusaders.org](http://www.gracecrusaders.org). Athletic fees must be paid before participation begins. Each athlete pays one Athletic Fee per school year regardless of how many sports they participate in.

**Uniform/Equipment Policy:** GCA will supply athletes with a basic uniform for those sports that require a specific team uniform. Any additional items that may be desired by a particular team/sport will be the responsibility of the athlete. (I.e., warm-up shirts, socks, shoes, jackets, etc.)

**Homeschool Rules & Fee:** Under the provisions of IHSA By-law 3.01, any student, including one who is homeschooled, must meet five specific requirements to be eligible for interscholastic participation:

1. The student must be enrolled at the member high school;
2. The student must be taking and passing a minimum of twenty-five (25) credit hours of work (the equivalent of five .5 credit courses) at the member school or in a program approved by the member school on a weekly and semester basis;
3. The student must be granted credit toward graduation by the member school for the work taken either at the member school or in a program it approved.
4. The student must be in compliance with all eligibility requirements of all IHSA By-laws. (Residence, Transfer, Scholastic Standing, etc.)
5. The student must pay applicable tuition and fees at the member high school.
