
Before you can Contribute

Step #1

Substep b: Click on “Request a Letter ID”

You will need your Social Security number, your Drivers License number, and your email for confirmation to be sent.

Submit your request and in 7 to 10 days you should receive via USPS a letter containing your ID.

Once you have the Letter ID in hand you can proceed to Step #2.
